In accordance with this statute, the Stratford Registrar of Voters Office will hold the following enrollment sessions:

Eighteenth day before Primary Day for State, District, and Municipal Primaries for towns with a population equal to or greater than 25,000:

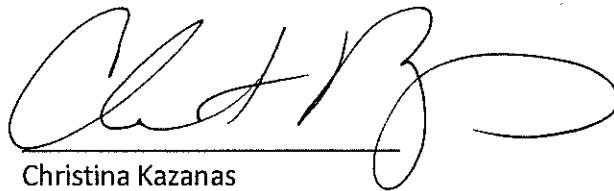
**Friday, July 24th, 2026 between 5:00PM and 7:00 PM

Fourteenth day before a primary - Enrollment Session for admission of all electors who are at least 17 years of age (must turn 18 on or before Election Day, November 3rd, 2026) and older, U.S. Citizens and residents of Stratford. The Registrars will, at such time, hear requests by people removed from the voter rolls for adding their names to the registry list. All qualified citizens are welcome to register to vote in person at this session but only those registering and designating a party affiliation of Democrat are allowed by state statute to vote in the August 11th, 2026 primary election.
